
1. The analysis is focused on **instruments listed on ETFplus Market.**

3. At the moment the instruments on ETFplus that can be classified as "Sustainable" are all ETFs.




ESG ETFs: new listed instruments and benchmark changes






ESG ETFs Breakdown: listed instruments






ESG ETFs Breakdown: Benchmark Area







ESG ETFs: AUM and listed instruments



ESG ETFs: Net Inflow


